There are 173 questions that Jesus asked recorded in the New Testament (some of these may be repeated in the gospels so numbers vary depending on how you count them, but it is nevertheless a lot!)

### **Read John 14 v 26**

How have you seen God at work in your life recently?

How have you seen him at work in your life in the past?

### **Read John 2 v 1-5**

The story of Jesus' first miracle - turning water into wine.

Seemingly Jesus was reluctant to act and needed a nudge into action by Mary, who understood exactly who He was - the son of God.

Is there something you need a bit of a nudge for that God is calling you to do?

How can we be more like Jesus in our actions?

How do we learn from what we do and how we react and behave?
