1. Think about and discuss as a group what aspect(s) of God's character has/have been highlighted to you with these names of God and in what way has it meant something to you?
2. How does Immanuel (God with us) help us to understand the other names of God more fully?
3. Read Jeremiah 31 v 31-34. How does this relate to Immanuel (God with us) and what changed between the Old Covenant (Old Testament) and the New Covenant (New Testament)?
4. In John 14 v 15-20 Jesus talks about us being in Him and Him being in us. Who is God calling us to "be Jesus" to individually, as a group and as a church?
5. Who do we need to personally introduce Immanuel to this Christmas?
