

We seek to transform communities by meeting needs and empowering people. Our primary means of fulfilling this aim is through our food hub and providing affordable good quality furniture and electrical goods for the home.

The Megacentre Rayleigh

We exists to bring joy, hope and life to the whole community. We believe that life is precious and that every child and young person should have the best opportunities to grow, learn, contribute and thrive in society and every family should have access to support to live full lives.

Our programmes include youth clubs, children's groups, complimentary education, family programmes and 1-2-1 support, supporting over 500 individuals and families each year.

We also offer recreational activities including Megazone Laser Tag and Soft Play.

The Olive Tree Centre

The Olive Tree Centre Trust, formed in 1998 has a vision of a counselling service for the community. Our aim was that all the counsellors would be committed Christians with a desire to help anyone who needs it whatever their situation. We are part of the Association of Christian Counsellors (ACC) who promote and uphold good, professional counselling practice as well as Christian faith.

In 2014 we expanded to incorporate

Southend Christian Counselling Service. We have bases in Eastwood and central Southend-on-Sea.

The Todman Centre

The Todman Centre was established specifically to support those over 55 in our local community. Currently it provides an opportunity for people to meet informally for a chat, hot drink and a very reasonably priced meal.

Volunteers from the churches of Rayleigh provide this service underpinned by a board of trustees. It provides a valuable forum for people to share the company of others in a friendly and safe environment. It may be possible to provide assisted transport through a local community scheme.
