📚 Knowledge - "Shares what you'd never know"

Key Theme: Spirit-revealed truth that builds up the Church

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Have you ever received insight about someone or something that you couldn't have known naturally? How did you handle it?
- 2. How can the gift of knowledge be used to encourage and not control others?
- 3. How do you discern the difference between natural understanding and a "divine download"?
- 4. Read **John 4:17-18** What impact did Jesus' revealed knowledge have on the woman, and what might that teach us about using this gift today?
- 5. What are some risks or responsibilities that come with receiving a word of knowledge?

Wisdom - "Shows which way to go"

Key Theme: Spirit-led application of God's truth

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Can you think of a time when the right course of action became clear through prayer or Godly counsel? Could this have been the gift of wisdom at work?
- 2. Read **1 Kings 3:16-28** How does Solomon's response reveal more than clever thinking? What does that say about the source of true wisdom?
- 3. When facing complex situations in ministry or relationships, how do you seek God's wisdom practically?
- 4. How can we grow in the gift of wisdom according to James 1:5?
- 5. What does "wisdom from above" look like in contrast to worldly wisdom (James 3:17)?

🕵 Discernment - "Helps the truth to show"

Key Theme: The supernatural ability to detect what is spiritually true or false

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Have you ever had a strong inner sense that something was spiritually "off," even if it looked right on the surface? How did you respond?
- 2. Read **Acts 16:16-18** Why was Paul disturbed by what the woman said, even though her words were technically true?
- 3. How can discernment help protect the Church from deception or manipulation?
- 4. How can we grow in discernment (see Hebrews 5:14)?
- 5. What does it mean to "test the spirits" in a healthy and biblical way (1 John 4:1)?

C Integrating the Gifts Together

Discussion Prompts:

1. Why is it important to see knowledge, wisdom, and discernment as distinct but complementary gifts?

- 2. Can you think of a situation where all three gifts might be needed together?
- 3. Which of these gifts do you feel most drawn to or see at work in your life? Which one would you like to grow in?
- 4. What might be some dangers of operating in one of these gifts without the others?
- 5. How can we create a safe and humble environment in our group/church for these gifts to be practiced?
