- Re-read Daniel 12:3 and Philippians 2:14-16
- How often do you notice the stars in the sky? -When did you last look and gaze in awe and wonder at the stars, and of God as creator of creation?
- Just as some of us take Vit D to support strong, healthy and resilient bones in our body- what are we consuming to support and help us in being spiritually alive, strong and resilient in faith, and in our service to God and others?
- Many people try to be celebrity stars in the world of entertainment, only to find their stardom temporary. God tells us how we can be eternal stars by being wise, leading others to know Jesus, for example, if we share our faith story with others (Daisy). How can we share your God story with others?
 When did you last do so?
- We can be truly radiant stars in God's light!. Jesus is our light source. Why is it so important to remain plugged into the Light souce of Jesus? What can cause our light to dim? How can we shine brighter in the spaces and places we find ourselves daily(John 8:12)?
- Is there anything we are keeping in the dark? Skeletons in the cupboard (not real skeletons!); something that we are ashamed of, guilty, unforgiveness, and addiction, behaviours, low self esteem, attitudes and thoughts that are keeping us captive, any strongholds keeping us down? In a trusted environment are you able to share some of this? It's not good or helpful to sweep things under the carpet, to push things down or ignore their existence this is where and when the enemy can get a foothold, a way into our thinking and being and cause havoc.

- Jesus came to offer life in all its fullness- freedom from things and people that harm us, he overcame death, he gives us the same authority and power to overcome- the same power he had in resurrection life. This is how we can shine as stars in our family, community, work places and church family. In the seen and the unseen moments.
- Jesus chooses us everytime especially when we mess up! His love for us is so high and wide and deep we can't understand it but it's for us and with us and in us. Jesus covers us with his protection, grace upon grace, mercy and he pursues us to shine like stars for him and for those we meet. How do you know and sense this?
- How can you be intentional with meeting well with Jesus and bring anything that's in the dark into the light? Releasing any strongholds over you? And how can you shine bright - what do you need to do?
