

RBC Life Group Questions Celebration
24th April 2026

In Psalm 118:24, we're told to "rejoice and be glad."

- What do you think it looks like to *actively choose* joy in an ordinary or difficult day?
- The message says celebration is a command, not a personality type. Do you find that challenging or freeing? Why?
- Jesus often participated in celebrations (like weddings and meals). What does this tell us about God's view of joy and community?
- The idea that "celebration flows from noticing" is central. What are some small, everyday things you might be overlooking that are worth celebrating?
- Joy is described as a deep strength (see Nehemiah 8:10). How have you experienced joy sustaining you during a tough season?
- "Celebration is contagious." Can you think of a time when someone else's joy impacted you—or when your attitude affected others?
- The message talks about celebrating *before* seeing answers (an act of faith; see also John 15:11). What makes this difficult, and how can we grow in this kind of faith?
- What is one practical way you could build a habit of celebration into your daily routine this week—and how can the group support you in that?
