

Unshakeable - WEEK 2: ONE IN CHRIST

Philippians 2:1-11(read the passage)

1. **What stood out to you most from Philippians 2:1-11, and why?**

Was there a particular phrase, idea or challenge that caught your attention?

2. **Paul says we can be "one in spirit and of one mind" without necessarily being identical.**

What are some of the differences between people in a church or Life Group that can actually become a strength rather than a source of division?

3. **"Unity is choosing Christ and one another, even when it costs us."**

What do you think unity can sometimes cost us — pride, being right, getting our own way, having the last word, etc.? Which of those do you find hardest?

4. **Philippians 2:3 tells us to "value others above yourselves."**

What might that look like in everyday life — at home, at work, in church or among friends — without becoming a doormat or ignoring your own needs?

5. **Jesus is our example of humility and serving others.**

Think of a situation where you disagree with someone. What could it look like to respond with the "mindset of Christ" rather than simply trying to prove your point?

6. **Verse 4 says, "Look not only to your own interests, but each of you to the interests of the others."**

Who might be around you right now that needs encouragement, a listening ear, practical help or simply someone to notice them?

7. **Is there a relationship where you might need to choose humility, forgiveness or grace this week?**

Without sharing anything you'd rather keep private, what could be one practical step towards restoring or strengthening that relationship?

8. **Paul ultimately points us back to Jesus.**

This week, how could you put the message into practice by **forgiving someone, encouraging someone, or serving someone?** Which one will you choose?

Optional prayer: Ask God to show each of us one person we can intentionally bless this week.
